Terms & Conditions

(General Public)

1. Customers will accept full responsibility for the contents of the container and agrees to additional charges, including taxes, if unacceptable waste is present.
2. All loads must be loaded evenly and kept level. An extra charge may apply if the container can not be hauled or if the driver has to spend extra time rearranging the load for safety reasons.
3. All loads have a maximum **weight limit of 10 tons**. Nitti Rolloff Services has the right to decline the transportation of a container exceeding this limit or to **charge \$75 ton every ton over the weight limit**.
4. Customer will accept full responsibility for any damages to their driveway, lawn etc., which may result from delivery and / or pick-up of a container from an agreed upon area by Nitti Rolloff Service, Inc regardless the weather conditions.
5. Nitti Rolloff will not cross someone elses property to access the customers unless they have written permission.
6. Customer shall pay Nitti Rolloff Services, Inc on a net **due on receipt** day basis for the services and/or equipment furnished by NRS in accordance with the charges and rates provided to the customer.
7. Finance charges will apply on any invoice(s) that are not paid in accordance with the terms above.
8. In the event Customer fails to pay Nitti Rolloff Services all amounts which become due under the agreement, Customer agrees to pay in addition to any amount due, collection fees of 30% the total amount due, accumulated interest and reasonable attorney's fees.
9. Rental fees may occur if a container is keep longer than the allotted time (normally 10 days).

10. What is acceptable and unacceptable for a **Construction/Demolition** load.

Acceptable: Wood (doors, windows, etc.), Sheetrock, Plaster, Insulation/Styrofoam, Ceramic Goods (sinks, tubs, toilets), Carpet, Tile, Metals (piping, duct work, etc.), Plastics (piping, wrapping, etc.), Brick/Concrete (not to exceed 10 tons) and Roofing.

Unacceptable: Braches, Stumps, Leaves, Grass, Appliances (refrigerator, washer, dryer, ac units, water heaters, etc.), Furniture, Mattress and Box Springs, Paint, Batteries, Tires, Motors (lawnmowers, motorcycles, etc), 55 Gal Drums, Hazardous Materials (oil, gas, antifreeze, asbestos, etc.), Florescent Lights and Ballast, Fuel Tanks, Ash, TVs / Monitors and any load containing more than 5% MSW (general household trash or food waste).

10. What is acceptable and unacceptable for a **Mixed or MSW** load. (MSW loads are not to exceed 4000 lbs per every 10 yards.)

Acceptable: General Household Trash, Clothes, Furniture (except hide-a-beds and mattresses), Paper Products, Food Waste, Wood (windows, doors, etc.), Sheetrock, Insulation/Styrofoam, Ceramic Goods (sinks, tubs, toilets), Plastics (piping, wrapping, etc.), Carpet, Tile and Metals (piping, duct work, etc.).

Unacceptable: Branches, Stumps, Leaves, Grass, Dirt, Brick/Concrete, Ash, Tires, Mattress, Appliances (refrigerators, washer, dryers, ac units, water heaters, etc.), Shingles, Plaster, Paint, Batteries, Motors (lawnmowers, motorcycles, etc), 55 Drums, Hazardous Materials (oil, gas, antifreeze, asbestos, etc.), Fluorescent Lights and Ballast, Fuel Tanks, and TVs / Monitors

11. Extra Charge Items (if considered unacceptable)

Brush - \$20/yard

Propane Tanks - \$50

Batteries - \$50

Car and Light Truck Tires - \$8

Pick-up or SUV Tires - \$8

Truck or Semi Tires - \$35 w/rim - \$50

Tractor Tires - \$100

Appliances - \$30 w/Freon - \$40

Electronics - Small - \$25 Medium - \$50 Large - \$75 Over - \$100

Motors/Lawnmowers - \$35 - \$70

Mattress /Furniture - \$20/\$20

Hide-A-Bed or Oversize Furniture - \$25

Over Weight Charges - \$75/ton

MSW - \$20/yard plus tax
